ORDER

By the Court's March 21, 2013 Order, attorney Thomas C. Swiers (AIS No. 9606050442) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Swiers has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Swiers's compliance with Rule 19-605.

By the Court's March 21, 2024 Order, attorney Tiffani D. Sloan (AIS No. 0312170256) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605. Attorney Sloan has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rules 19-409(5)(F), 19-503(c)(6), and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Sloan's compliance with Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605.

By the Court's March 20, 2025 Order, attorney Carolyn J. Moses (AIS No. 8812160121) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605. Attorney Moses has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rules 19-409(5)(F), 19-503(c)(6), and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Moses's compliance with Rules 19-409, 19-503, and 19-605.

Accordingly, it is this 7th day of April 2025, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that attorneys

Thomas C. Swiers (AIS No. 9606050442),

Tiffani D. Sloan (AIS No. 0312170256), and

Carolyn J. Moses (AIS No. 8812160121),

are restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall send notice in accordance with Rule 19-761.
