ORDER

By the Court's March 20, 2025 Order, attorney Amanda M. Darnell-Stone (AIS No. 2312201011) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Darnell-Stone has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Darnell-Stones's compliance with Rule 19-605.

By the Court's March 20, 2025 Order, attorney Archie C. Hogan III (AIS No. 2306120002) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c). Attorney Hogan has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Hogan's compliance with Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c).

Accordingly, it is this 21st day of April 2025, by the Supreme Court of Maryland, ORDERED that attorneys

are restored to good standing by the Court and are again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further
